- ❖ 2018-19 Morning Montessori tuition is \$570 per month, and Montessori Kindergarten tuition is \$725 per month
- ❖ Before and Afternoon program rates vary depending upon your child's schedule

SCHEDULE

- ❖ Morning Montessori is from 8:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. Mon.-Fri.; after Morning Montessori, Kindergarteners join together to work in the Montessori Classroom from 1 p.m. - 3 p.m., Mon.-Thurs.
- ❖ For those children needing additional care, we offer *flexible* schedules: early care at 7:30 a.m. and our Afternoon Program is from 11:30 am to 5:30 p.m. with several pick-up times.



About HPMS

- ❖ HPMS Children's Houses serve children 33 months to 6 years
- ❖ We have two fully equipped Montessori classrooms with twenty children in each room
- ❖ Each classroom is rich with materials to inspire learning and independence

For those children needing additional care, we offer early care at 7:30 a.m. and afternoon care from 11:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., with pick-up times at 1:00, 3:00, 4:00, 4:30, 5:00, and 5:30 p.m.
